

WELCOME TO SUMMER CAMP

Dear Parent:

Welcome to St. Paul Lutheran Church Summer Camp, a Christ-filled summer learning adventure! We are planning exciting activities and field trips designed to incorporate adventure and learning. I am still working on the staffing for the summer. Mrs. Hruska will be busy with her second baby coming along in June. A few former students/college students will be joining us at least for this summer.

Here is some basic information for those that are new to the program. A weekly schedule that incorporates a wide variety of fun and interesting activities will be provided in a weekly newsletter. Field trips, swimming times, and a host of other activities will all be listed. We will need a permission form for each off campus activity. Permission forms will be given to the parents on Friday for the following week's activities. Please make sure that permission forms and weekly fees are returned each week on Monday. The weekly fee will be \$175 per child per week or \$320 for two children or \$35/day/child. The child's attendance must be confirmed at the beginning of the week.

Dress code is cool, casual and comfortable. We will spend time outside, so please dress your child, appropriately. Make sure that shoes are suitable for activity. Jellies, some sandals and dressier shoes can be uncomfortable and dangerous for active campers. A change of clothes is highly advisable and can be kept packed in the backpack. Also, do not forget to pack two snacks, a lunch and drink(s). Refrigeration is available when we are on campus. On those afternoons we are off campus/field trips, refrigeration will not be available.

You may drop your campers off beginning at 7:00am in the Annex across the street from the church/school. Please escort your campers in and sign them in. Please pick up your child by 6:00pm in the same location. Regular summer camp activities and programs will take place between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. If you need early drop off or late pick up, please advise an adult leader as early in the week as possible.

I am looking forward to a wonderful summer. May God richly bless you as the school year winds down and as we prepare for a lot of fun.
